	27th April	<b>Geodiversity and biodiversity</b> - guided visit walking in the southern part of Beigua Geopark from Faie to Pratorotondo to investigate the characteristics of the local vegetation and its relationship with the geological substratum.
	4th May	<b>Geodiversity and biodiversity</b> - guided walk to discover the botanical features (spring flowers) of the Geopark along the Alta Via dei Monti Liguri trail.
	11th May	<b>Geodiversity and geoarchaeology</b> – guided walk in the archaeological sites of the Beigua Geopark to discover the rock engravings of the Neolithic Age. With the support of the Italian Alpine Club – Finale Ligure Section.
