This northern area of the Geopark has an impressive level of geodiversity, rich cultural heritage and beautiful woodlands. Our dedicated guide, Julianna Sárdy, presented the geological key section of the Zsidó Hill (with some interactive actions, e.g. dip logging with our guests), the visitors could learn about the formation of the picturesque gorge and small waterfall at the Római-fürdő ('Roman Bath') geosite. The participants could also get acquainted with the cultural history of Jásd village and the surrounding area: they visited the Szentkút ('Saint Spring'), which is one of the oldest pilgrimage sites in Hungary, dating back more than 600 years.

The first, a Limestone Pavement Walk at Killykeen was hosted in partnership with Ulster Wildlife as we joined Senior Scientific Officer Simon Grey for a wander through the limestone grasslands and hazel woodlands of Killykeegan National Nature Reserve as part of our Wildlife Walk.

The most successful event was our Wild Caving at Pollnagollum. This Victorian show cave was very popular with a lot of interest from adults and children. The event was led by caving expert and Geopark Guide Helen with participants being led on an underground adventure exploring the Victorian showcave, Pollnagollum, that lies under Belmore Forest, in the heart of Cuilcagh Lakelands Geopark. Participants learned how the cave has formed and how imporant the Geology of this landscape is.

Fifty people visited the Low Noise Underground Laboratory in Rustrel, which was opened exceptionally on May 21st for this journey in the heart of the karst. Formerly a military infrastructure, this site is now a multidisciplinary research laboratory. A set of galleries bored into the limestone massif offers direct access to the heart of the karst. A hydrogeologist and an engineer presented the history of the site and explained the hydrogeological research carried out in the galleries. The site is equipped with instruments to measure the physical and chemical characteristics of the water that flows through the rock to the galleries. This visit allowed a better understanding of the karst hydrological system and the water resource management.

During the European Geoparks Week, reknown scientists reported on current research work in Vulkaneifel:

- On Tuesday, May 24, 2022, Prof. Dr. Michael Ort (Northern Arizona University), Prof. Dr. Volker Lorenz (University of Würzburg) and Prof. Dr. Georg Büchel (University of Jena) reported on the latest research findings and explored the question of where the next volcano will erupt. The three scientists introduced the size, explosiveness and duration of the extremely different volcanic activities worldwide, presented the volcanic shape of a Maar Diatreme volcano, which is typical for the West Eifel, and tried to predict as accurately as possible when and where the next volcano in the West Eifel will erupt.
- On Wednesday, June 1, 2022, Prof. Dr. Hans-Ulrich Schmincke and Dr. Mari Sumita (GEOMAR Helmholtz Kiel) reported on new ideas about the formation of some Eifel maars using the example of Pulvermaar. The investigations we have started at Pulvermaar and other neighboring maars have shown that these maars were probably formed by CO2 -gas eruptions. The "slagged volcanic spheres" are an important piece of evidence," said Prof. Dr. Schmincke.
